

10-Year Framework of Programmes on Sustainable Consumption and Production



One of the important programmatic outcomes from the **U.N. Conference on Sustainable Development (Rio+20)** was the adoption of the **10-Year Framework of Programmes (10YFP) on Sustainable Consumption and Production (SCP)** — commonly referred to as the 10YFP.

The 10YFP was initiated to promote resource efficiency and sustainability, and does this through facilitating knowledge exchange on specific topics, funding related projects, and connecting a diverse group of global stakeholders which includes governments, businesses, NGOs, and technical experts. Now that the 10YFP has reached the midpoint of its initial term, partners are working together to review progress and develop a strategy for the SCP program moving forward.

In 2015 the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development was adopted by 193 nations. It has 17 goals (17 Sustainable Development Goals.) and SCP is one of its components, being Goal No 12 (Goal 12). SCP is also reflected in a number of other Targets identified in other SDGs and is among the few priority themes of SDGs.

The United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) serves as the 10YFP Secretariat.

The ARSCP is crafted as the Technical arm of AMCEN spearheads the implementation of the 10YFP on SCP in Africa. The first African 10YFP was developed in 2004, being the first global regional framework on SCP. It gave valuable inputs into the development of the global framework adopted in Rio in 2012. Thereafter, Africa developed a Roadmap for 10YFP on SCP to lead the region to 2022 and beyond.
